Early Years

Year 1 children completed their Phonics Screening Check in June 2025. It contained 40 words including a mixture of real words and pseudo-words. Children needed to score 32 to pass.

KS2 SATs Results 2025

Year 6 children completed their National Curriculum Assessments (commonly known as SATs) in May 2024 for maths; reading; and grammar, punctuation and spelling. At the end of KS2, children are assessed through both teacher assessments and SATs tests, except for writing which is purely teacher assessed.
